

| 1. Vase of Tulips (any type)  | 3 stems (own foliage)              |
| 2. Vase of Daffodils<br>(trumpet longer than petals)                                  | any colours - 3 stems (no foliage) |
| 3. Vase of miniature Daffodils  | 3 stems (no foliage)               |
| 4. Vase of Daffodils<br>(any type other than those in class 2 or 3)                   | 3 stems (no foliage)               |
| 5. Vase of any other bulbs or corms not listed above                                  |                                    |
| 6. Specimen bloom   | 1 stem of any bulb or corm         |
| 7. Pot plant - flowering*   | pot or bowl any size               |
| 8. Pot plant - foliage*   | pot or bowl any size               |
| 9. Vase of Polyanthus   | 5 stems - any type                 |
| 10. Pansies or Violas   | 5 blooms (one or more varieties)   |
| 11. Vase of Wallflowers   | 5 stems of any variety             |
| 12. Camelia   | 1 bloom in a saucer                |
| 13. Camelia   | 3 stems in a vase (any colour/s)   |
| 14. Hellebore   | 3 blooms in a saucer               |
| 15. Container of spring flowers/foilage from the garden<br>(not to exceed 60cm width) |                                    |
| 16. Blossom   | 1 to 3 stems                       |
