

-3. VASE OF MINIATURE DAFFODILS	<i>3 STEMS (NO FOLIAGE)</i>
-4. VASE OF DAFFODILS <i>(ANY TYPE OTHER THAN THOSE IN CLASS 2 OR 3)</i>	<i>3 STEMS (NO FOLIAGE)</i>
-5. VASE OF ANY OTHER BULBS OR CORMS NOT LISTED ABOVE	
-6. SPECIMEN BLOOM	<i>1 STEM OF ANY BULB OR CORM</i>
-7. VASE OF POLYANTHUS	<i>5 STEMS - ANY TYPE</i>
-8. PANSIES OR VIOLAS	<i>5 BLOOMS (ONE OR MORE VARIETIES)</i>
-9. VASE OF WALLFLOWERS	<i>5 STEMS OF ANY VARIETY</i>
-10. CAMELIA	<i>1 BLOOM IN A SAUCER</i>
-11. CAMELIA	<i>3 STEMS IN A VASE (ANY COLOUR/S)</i>
-12. HELLEBORE	<i>3 BLOOMS IN A SAUCER</i>
-13. BLOSSOM	<i>1 TO 3 STEMS</i>
