2.Vase of Daffodils ( <i>trumpet longer than petals</i> )	Any colours - 3 stems ( <i>no foliage</i> )
3.Double Daffodils ( <i>with multi flowers</i> )	3 stems
4.Vase of miniature Daffodils	3 stems
5.Vase of Daffodils ( <i>any type other than those in class 2,3 or 4</i> )	5 blooms ( <i>no foliage</i> )
6.Vase of any other bulbs or corms not listed above	
7.Specimin bloom	1 stem of any bulb or corm
8.Pot Plant—flowering*	pot or bowl any size
9.Pot Plant—foliage*	pot or bowl any size
10.Vase of Polyanthus	5 stems - any type
11.Pansies or Violas	5 blooms (1 or more varieties)
12.Vase of Wallflowers	5 stems of any variety
13.Camelia	1 bloom in a saucer
14.Camelia	3 stems in a vase ( <i>any colour/s</i> )
15.Hellebore	3 blooms in a saucer
16.Container of Spring flowers/foliage from the garden ( <i>not to exceed 60cm in width</i> )	
17.Blossom	1-3 stems

18.Rhubarb	3 sticks
19.Cookery - bread rolls	5 on a plate
20.Cookery - chocolate chip cookies	5 on a plate


## RULES & NOTICES

**\*these may also include a Cactus or Succulent**




**All flowers and vegetables must have been grown in the exhibitors own ground.**

Narcissus is the Latin name for daffodil. There are many different 'divisions' (types) of daffodils. Some are featured in our Schedule. For example Trumpet daffodil where the 'trumpet' (or cup) is longer than the petals and Double daffodil which has a clustered cup and petals.
