1.Vase of Tulips (<i>any type</i>)	<i>3 stems (own foliage)</i>
2.Vase of Daffodils (<i>trumpet longer than petals</i>)	<i>Any colours - 3 stems (no foliage)</i>
3.Vase of miniature Narcissi	<i>3 stems (no foliage)</i>
4.Vase of Narcissi (<i>any type other than those in class 2 or 3</i>)	<i>3 stems (no foliage)</i>
5.Vase of any other bulbs or corms not listed above	
6.Specimen bloom	<i>1 stem of any bulb or corm</i>
7.Pot Plant—flowering*	<i>pot or bowl any size</i>
8.Pot Plant—foliage*	<i>pot or bowl any size</i>
9.Vase of Polyanthus	<i>5 stems - any type</i>
10.Pansies or Violas	<i>5 blooms (1 or more varieties)</i>
11.Vase of Wallflowers	<i>5 stems of any variety</i>
12.Camelia	<i>1 bloom in a saucer</i>
13.Camelia	<i>3 stems in a vase (any colour/s)</i>
14.Hellebore	<i>3 blooms in a saucer</i>
15.Container of Spring flowers/foilage from the garden (<i>not to exceed 60cm in width</i>)	
16.Blossom	<i>1-3 stems</i>

17.Rhubarb	<i>3 sticks</i>
18.Cookery - spring vegetable quiche	<i>1 on a plate</i>
19.Cookery - flapjacks	<i>3 pieces on a plate</i>
20.A photograph “ Spring Has Sprung” (no larger than A4)	
21.Children’s Class - an egg cup full of flowers
